

AdBook Documentation

Basics

AdBook v1.0 uses SQLite version 1.20 as database system. At first start AdBook will create an empty database file by the name "AdBook.sld" if no database file of that name is present.

Configuration File

The configuration file is "AdBook.ini". It contains the following settings:

```
[Settings]
ip=jude1234.no-ip.info
dbcreate=1
```

ip contains the address of the server. This could be one of these types.

- An IP address in the local LAN or WLAN like 192.168.178.33
- A fixed internet ip address like "myipaddress.no-ip.org"

If an ip address is given then AdBook will try to connect to that address, if no ip is set or if there is no ini file then it will work local.

Dbcreate=1 means that Adbook has created an empty database. If dbcreate=0 or if there is no ini file then AdBook will try to create an empty database. If a database exists already or dbcreate=1 AdBook will use that one. Nothing is created then.

Functions

Search

Makes a partial search for the characters given and finds the next matching record. Search is case sensitive, that means "F" is not equal to "f".

Create New

This button empties all inputfields and creates a new record. After filling the fields press Save to write the changes to the database.

Save

Saves any changes you have made to the current record.

Delete

Deletes the current record.

Print List

No functionality yet.

Exit

Terminates the program.

Sort Options

A click on any one of these option buttons sorts the records according to the connected index.

Up/Down Control

Flips one by one through the records up or down according to the selected index.
